

What Does Delta Comfort Plus Include?

Delta Comfort Plus includes up to 3 inches of additional legroom compared to Main Cabin, priority boarding, dedicated overhead bin space, complimentary premium snacks, free alcoholic beverages on most flights, and personal entertainment device holders on equipped aircraft, all for a fare premium typically ranging from \$40 to \$200 above Main Cabin depending on the route. Understanding everything Comfort+ includes helps you assess whether the premium over Main Cabin produces good value for your specific trip.

Extra Legroom Comfort+ seats provide up to 3 inches of additional legroom compared to Main Cabin. On most aircraft, Comfort+ seats have 34-36 inches of pitch (legroom) versus Main Cabin's 31-32 inches. This may seem like a small difference, but on flights longer than 2 hours, the additional space produces a noticeable improvement in comfort.

Priority Boarding Comfort+ passengers board in Zone 1 along with Sky Priority customers and Medallion members. This means earlier access to overhead bin space, less rushed boarding experience, and more time to settle in before the rest of the cabin boards.

Dedicated Overhead Bin Space The overhead bins above Comfort+ seats are designated for Comfort+ passenger use. This significantly reduces the risk of running out of overhead space, which is a common problem on full flights when Main Cabin passengers ahead of you have already filled the bins.

Premium Snacks Complimentary premium snack offerings on Comfort+ exceed the standard Main Cabin snacks. Specific offerings vary by route and time of day but typically include better quality and variety than Main Cabin's basic snacks.

Complimentary Alcoholic Beverages On flights of 251+ miles within the continental US and on most international flights, Comfort+ includes complimentary beer, wine, and spirits. Main Cabin charges for alcoholic beverages on most flights, making this a meaningful Comfort+ benefit for passengers who would otherwise purchase drinks.

Personal Entertainment Device Holders Equipped Comfort+ seats include device holders that hold tablets and phones at viewing angles, useful for streaming entertainment during the flight without holding the device.

Power Outlets at Each Seat Most modern Delta aircraft equip Comfort+ seats with AC power outlets and USB charging ports for personal devices.

Free Streaming Entertainment Delta Studio streaming entertainment is free for all passengers including Comfort+. The Comfort+ device holders make this benefit easier to enjoy.

Free Texting T-Mobile customers receive complimentary in-flight messaging on all Delta flights. Comfort+ does not include Wi-Fi as a fare class feature – Wi-Fi service is separate.

What Comfort Plus Does Not Include

Setting clear expectations about what Comfort+ does not include prevents disappointment and helps you understand the value relative to higher cabin classes.

No Lie-Flat Seats Comfort+ seats are upright with some recline but are not lie-flat. For lie-flat seating, Delta Premium Select or Delta One on equipped aircraft are required.

No Premium Dining The premium snack offering on Comfort+ does not include hot meal service. For premium dining including hot meals, Delta Premium Select on international flights and Delta One are required.

No Delta Sky Club Access Comfort+ does not include access to Delta Sky Club lounges. Access requires Medallion status, paid membership, or Delta Reserve American Express card membership.

No Priority Baggage While Comfort+ provides priority boarding, it does not include priority baggage handling on arrival. Sky Priority baggage handling requires higher status or fare class.

No Free Wi-Fi Wi-Fi service is the same purchase requirement for Comfort+ as for Main Cabin. Free Wi-Fi for all passengers is being rolled out across the Delta fleet but is separate from the Comfort+ benefits.

Standard SkyMiles Earning Rates Comfort+ earns SkyMiles at the same per-dollar rates as Main Cabin. The fare class does not provide a higher earning multiplier – earning is based on the fare paid times your Medallion-based multiplier.

How Comfort Plus Pricing Works

Understanding how Comfort+ pricing is structured helps you make informed decisions about when the premium produces good value.

Standard Fare Premium Over Main Cabin The Comfort+ fare is typically \$40 to \$200 above the same flight's Main Cabin fare. The premium varies by:

- Flight duration (longer flights typically have larger premiums)
- Route demand (high-demand routes have larger premiums)
- Booking timing (last-minute bookings may have larger or smaller premiums)
- Day of week (peak travel days typically have larger premiums)

Comfort+ Upgrade Costs When upgrading from Main Cabin to Comfort+ at check-in (24 hours before departure), the upgrade cost is typically lower than the original booking premium. Delta sometimes offers Comfort+ upgrades at \$30-\$80 even when the original premium was higher.

Medallion Complimentary Upgrades Diamond, Platinum, and Gold Medallion members receive complimentary Comfort+ upgrades when booked in eligible Main Cabin fare classes (some restricted classes are excluded). These upgrades clear automatically if seats are available – no purchase needed.

Comfort+ Through Award Booking Booking Comfort+ directly with SkyMiles is available on some flights. The mileage cost is higher than Main Cabin but typically represents reasonable value for the extra benefits.

When Comfort Plus Is Worth the Premium

For most travelers, Comfort+ is a thoughtful middle-ground purchase. Specific situations particularly favor the upgrade.

Flights Over 3 Hours On flights longer than 3 hours, the additional legroom produces meaningful comfort improvement. The premium for Comfort+ on a 4-6 hour transcontinental flight (typically \$80-\$150) is small relative to the comfort difference over the duration.

Red-Eye and Long-Haul Flights On overnight flights and international flights longer than 6 hours, Comfort+'s extra legroom is particularly valuable. The ability to stretch and shift positions during the flight improves sleep and reduces post-flight fatigue.

Tall Travelers For passengers over 6 feet tall, Main Cabin's 31-32 inches of pitch can be cramped. The additional 3 inches in Comfort+ specifically addresses this issue. Tall

travelers often find Comfort+ premium worthwhile on flights as short as 90 minutes.

Business Travel With Productivity Goals The dedicated overhead bin space and priority boarding allow business travelers to settle in quickly and use flight time productively. The extra legroom makes laptop use more comfortable.

Multi-Segment Trips With Tight Connections Comfort+'s priority boarding helps for connections where you need to deplane and get to the next gate quickly. The earlier off-the-plane timing for Comfort+ passengers provides meaningful advantage on tight connections.

Special Occasions For trips that matter — anniversaries, important business meetings, post-difficult-week vacation departures — the Comfort+ premium produces a meaningfully better travel experience at modest cost.

When Comfort Plus Is Not Worth the Premium

Comfort+ does not always produce good value. Several situations favor sticking with Main Cabin.

Very Short Flights On flights under 90 minutes, the comfort benefit of additional legroom is brief and may not justify the premium. A 45-minute flight in Main Cabin is usually fine even for passengers who would choose Comfort+ on longer trips.

Very Tight Budget When travel budget is strictly limited, Main Cabin's standard features cover the essential travel experience. The Comfort+ premium can be saved and applied to other trip components.

Travel Without Carry-On If you are traveling with only a personal item that fits under the seat, the dedicated overhead bin benefit is irrelevant. Most other Comfort+ benefits remain valuable, but one significant advantage doesn't apply.

Routes With Limited Comfort+ Premium Quality On some routes, particularly short regional flights, the Comfort+ product is less differentiated from Main Cabin — same aircraft type, similar service. The premium for these flights produces less marginal benefit than on longer flights with more differentiated service.

Strong Medallion Status For Diamond and Platinum Medallion members, complimentary Comfort+ upgrades clear automatically on most eligible bookings. Paying for Comfort+ when you would have received it free as a Medallion upgrade is wasteful. Book Main Cabin and let the upgrade clear.

Free Wi-Fi or Other Future Benefits If your priority for the flight is connectivity rather than comfort, the standard purchase requirements for Wi-Fi apply equally to Comfort+ and Main Cabin. Spending the Comfort+ premium would not advance the Wi-Fi goal.

Comparing Comfort Plus to Delta Premium Select and Delta One

Understanding how Comfort+ compares to Delta's higher cabin products helps you select the right cabin class for your priorities and budget.

Delta Premium Select Available on equipped widebody aircraft (mainly international and some premium domestic). Premium Select includes wider seats with more recline, premium dining with hot meal service, larger personal entertainment screens, and enhanced amenities. The premium over Comfort+ is typically \$200-\$800 depending on route and route length.

For international flights longer than 8 hours, Premium Select represents a meaningful improvement over Comfort+ that may be worth the additional premium. For shorter flights or routes without widebody equipment, Premium Select is not available.

Delta One Delta's flagship business class product. Includes lie-flat seats (or near-lie-flat on some routes), premium dining with multiple-course meals, Delta Sky Club access, priority airport services, and premium amenity kits. Available on transcontinental routes and international long-haul.

Delta One premium over Comfort+ ranges from \$1,000 to \$5,000+ depending on route and travel dates. The premium is substantial but produces a fundamentally different travel experience – the ability to sleep flat on long flights, premium meal service, and significant ground service enhancements.

The Tier Comparison For most domestic travelers, the choice is between Main Cabin and Comfort+, with Comfort+ often producing good value on flights over 2-3 hours. Delta One is typically reserved for special long-haul travel where the premium produces transformative experience improvements. Premium Select is the middle international option for travelers who want enhanced experience without the Delta One premium.

How to Book Comfort Plus

Booking Comfort+ follows the same general process as any Delta booking with the fare class selection determining what's included.

Through Delta.com or the App Search for flights as normal. On the flight selection screen, the price displays for each cabin class. Click Comfort+ to select that cabin and continue to seat selection. The seat map shows specifically designated Comfort+ seats.

Delta operates multiple aircraft types, and the Comfort+ experience can vary depending on the specific aircraft serving your flight.

Boeing 717 Aircraft Smaller regional jets. Comfort+ section has typical extra legroom but no in-seat entertainment screens. Personal device entertainment via Delta Studio works on all aircraft.

Boeing 737-800 and -900 Aircraft Standard narrowbody domestic aircraft. Comfort+ provides typical benefits including extra legroom, priority boarding, and premium snacks. Some routes have personal seatback entertainment screens.

Airbus A220 Aircraft Modern regional aircraft with enhanced cabin experience throughout. Comfort+ benefits apply with the additional advantage of overall cabin upgrades on this newer aircraft type.
