

Can I Change My Name on a Delta Airlines Reservation?

Updated: May 19, 2026

Yes, you can change your name on a Delta Airlines reservation for minor spelling corrections of up to three characters or for legal name changes supported by a marriage certificate or court order, but only by calling ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 since the Delta app and website do not support name modifications after booking is confirmed. An agent at ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 can assess your specific correction, confirm whether it qualifies as a minor fix or requires documentation, and process the change directly after verifying your identity. Full passenger substitution “changing the name to a completely different person” is never permitted since Delta tickets are non-transferable under TSA Secure Flight regulations.

What Name Changes Are Permitted on Delta Reservations

Delta's name change policy distinguishes between three categories of name modification, each with different eligibility rules and processes.

Permitted: Minor Spelling Corrections Typographical errors of up to three characters “transposed letters, dropped characters, common misspellings” are correctable by calling ☎+1-(866)-332-0756. No documentation beyond identity verification is required. The correction is typically processed during the call itself at no charge on most fare classes. This is the most common name change situation and the most straightforward to resolve.

Permitted: Legal Name Changes With Documentation When a passenger's legal name has officially changed since booking “through marriage, divorce, or court order” Delta processes the name change with appropriate supporting documentation. The new name must match the government-issued ID the passenger will present at the airport. Call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 to initiate this process and allow at least one week before travel for processing.

Not Permitted: Passenger Substitution Changing the name on a ticket to an entirely different person “someone other than the original ticketed passenger” is never permitted. Delta tickets are non-transferable under both Delta's contract of carriage and TSA's aviation security regulations. If the wrong person was booked, the ticket must be cancelled under applicable fare rules and a new ticket purchased for the correct person. Call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 to understand the cancellation options for your specific

fare class.

How Eligibility Is Determined

When you call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 to request a name change, the agent assesses eligibility based on the specific details of your request. Understanding the factors that determine eligibility helps you prepare an accurate description of what needs to change.

Character Count Assessment The agent counts the number of characters that need to change in the passenger name field. A change of three or fewer characters qualifies as a minor correction. A change of four or more characters typically requires the legal name change documentation process. The count is made across all name fields combined “ first, middle, and last ” not separately per field.

Nature of Change Assessment Beyond character count, the agent assesses whether the change reflects a genuine correction of a booking error (typo or legal name change) or an attempt to substitute a different passenger. A name that changes completely “ from "Robert Johnson" to "Maria Garcia" ” is clearly a substitution regardless of character count, and is not permitted under any circumstances.

Fare Class Assessment The eligible correction pathway may vary by fare class. Basic Economy tickets have the most restrictive name change rules and may face higher reissuance costs than Main Cabin or above. The agent confirms the fare class implication before processing any correction.

Timing Assessment Corrections made further from departure are more straightforward than corrections made close to departure. The 72-hour Secure Flight transmission window means corrections processed earlier propagate more reliably to the boarding pass. Same-day corrections require priority handling. All of these assessments are made by the agent during the call.

When to Call “ Timing Matters

The timing of your call to ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 significantly affects both the ease of the correction process and the reliability of the outcome.

Immediately Upon Discovering the Error The moment you notice a name discrepancy between your ticket and your ID is the right moment to call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756. Earlier corrections are universally easier to process and more certain to appear correctly on the boarding pass than corrections made close to departure.

Within 24 Hours of Purchase If the name error is noticed within 24 hours of purchasing the ticket, an alternative to name correction exists: the DOT's 24-hour cancellation rule allows

cancellation for a full cash refund, after which you can rebook with the correct name. This zero-cost alternative is only available when both the cancellation is within 24 hours of purchase and the travel date is at least 7 days away. The agent at ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 advises whether the correction or the cancellation-rebooking produces the better outcome for your specific fare class and fare level.

At Least 72 Hours Before Departure For corrections that cannot use the 24-hour cancellation alternative, processing the correction at least 72 hours before departure ensures it is included in the TSA Secure Flight transmission and appears reliably on the boarding pass at check-in.

Same Day of Travel Same-day corrections are possible through ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 with priority handling. Call immediately, identify yourself as having a same-day departure, and go to the Delta check-in counter simultaneously. Counter agents and phone agents can coordinate for the fastest same-day resolution.

Legal Name Change Process “ Step by Step

The legal name change process on a Delta reservation involves more steps than a minor correction but is completely manageable when initiated with adequate lead time before travel.

Step 1: Call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 Give your confirmation number and state that you have had a legal name change due to marriage, divorce, or court order. The agent opens the legal name change process for your booking.

Step 2: Provide the New Legal Name Give the agent the exact correct name from your current government-issued ID “ the name that will appear on the document you present at the airport and at all international checkpoints.

Step 3: Receive Documentation Submission Instructions The agent explains how to submit the required documentation. The most common submission method is uploading through Delta's customer care portal. Less commonly, the agent may provide an email address for document submission. Get the exact submission method and address before ending the call.

Step 4: Submit Documentation Promptly Upload or email your marriage certificate, divorce decree, or court order as soon as possible after the call. The documentation review process begins when the documents are received, not when the call is made. Every day of delay in submitting documentation is a day removed from your processing timeline.

Step 5: Get and Track Your Case Reference Number Ask the agent for a case reference number before ending the call. This number allows any future agent to immediately locate and review your legal name change request if you need to follow up on processing status.

Step 6: Allow Processing Time Legal name change documentation review takes several business days after submission. Allow at least one full week between documentation submission and your travel date. For travel within a week of the legal name change need, call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 and explain the urgency â€” agents may escalate the review timeline for time-sensitive situations.

Step 7: Verify at the 24-Hour Check-In Mark When online check-in opens 24 hours before departure, verify that your boarding pass shows the corrected legal name. If the old name still appears, call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 immediately with your case reference number.

Name Changes on Award Reservations

SkyMiles award reservations follow the same name change process as revenue tickets â€” call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 with your confirmation number and the correct name.

Several award-specific considerations apply.

The miles cost of the award is not affected by a name correction. No additional miles are charged and no miles are refunded. The correction updates only the passenger name field while preserving all other award booking elements including the mileage redemption, seat assignment, and routing.

If the SkyMiles account that booked the award has the same name error in the profile, ask the agent to update both the specific booking name and the account profile name in the same call. Updating only the booking leaves the profile with the incorrect name that will auto-populate on all future award bookings.

For award bookings on SkyTeam partner airlines booked through SkyMiles, the name correction may require coordination between Delta and the operating partner. Call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 and the agent coordinates the correction across both systems as needed.

Protecting Downstream Bookings After a Name Correction

If you discover a name error on one Delta booking, it is worth checking other upcoming Delta bookings in your account for the same error. A name error in your SkyMiles profile auto-populates to every booking made while logged into that account.

Call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 and ask the agent to check all upcoming bookings in your account for name consistency after completing any correction. The agent can process corrections on multiple upcoming bookings in a single call, preventing you from discovering the same error again on a future trip.

Update your SkyMiles profile name after any correction to prevent the error from repeating. The agent at ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 can update the profile name simultaneously wit

h correcting any specific booking. This combined approach â€” booking correction plus profile update â€” is the most thorough resolution.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I change my name on a Delta reservation if I recently got married? Call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 with your marriage certificate ready â€” yes, Delta processes legal name changes for recently married passengers with proper documentation. The agent initiates the process and explains the documentation submission method. Allow at least one week before travel for the change to be processed.

Can I change my name on a Delta reservation booked through a travel agency? Call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 first â€” Delta agents can often process name corrections directly even for agency-booked tickets without requiring the agency to initiate the change. The agent confirms whether direct correction is possible for your specific booking.

Can I change my name on a Delta reservation more than once? Call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 â€” there is no published limit on the number of corrections a reservation can receive, though each correction is assessed individually for eligibility. Multiple changes to the same name field may raise questions about the nature of the changes that the agent resolves through the standard eligibility assessment.

Can I change my name on a Delta reservation the same day as travel? Call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 immediately and identify yourself as having a same-day departure â€” yes, same-day corrections are processed with priority handling. Simultaneously proceed to the Delta check-in counter at the airport for the fastest combined resolution.

Can I change my name on a Delta reservation without a MileagePlus account? Call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 â€” yes, name corrections are processed for guest bookings without a SkyMiles account. Identity verification for guest bookings uses the booking confirmation number, date of birth, and billing information used at purchase rather than MileagePlus credentials.

Quick Reference: Delta Reservation Name Change

Permitted changes: Minor corrections up to 3 characters, legal name changes with documentation.

Not permitted: Full passenger substitution â€” cancel and rebook for wrong person.

Only channel: Call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 app and website excluded for security reasons.

Minor correction timeline: Completed during the call 10 to 15 minutes.

Legal change timeline: Several business days after documentation submission.

24-hour alternative: Cancel for full refund + rebook 100 only within 24 hours of purchase.

Award bookings: Same process 100 no additional miles charged for correction.

Profile update: Ask agent to update SkyMiles profile name simultaneously.

Multiple bookings: Ask agent to check all upcoming bookings for same error.

Case reference: Always get one 100 essential for follow-up.

Building a Name Verification System for All Future Delta Bookings

After experiencing a name issue on Delta, implementing a systematic verification approach for all future bookings prevents the same situation from recurring. The habits below take less than 5 minutes per booking and eliminate virtually all name-related complications.

Habit 1: Book Through Your SkyMiles Account When you book while logged into your SkyMiles account on Delta.com or the Delta app, your name auto-populates from your profile rather than being typed manually. If your SkyMiles profile shows the correct legal name, every booking made through your account carries the correct name automatically without any manual entry risk.

Call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 to verify that your SkyMiles profile name exactly matches your government-issued ID before making any booking. The agent checks the profile name against the standard for your document type and updates it if any discrepancy exists. This five-minute call prevents name errors on every future booking indefinitely.

Habit 2: Read the Confirmation Screen Before Purchasing The booking confirmation screen displays the passenger name as it will appear on the ticket. Reading this against your physical ID before clicking the final purchase button is the last zero-cost opportunity to catch any error. An error caught on the confirmation screen requires only a backtrack and retype 100 no name change process, no phone call, no fee.

Habit 3: Verify Within 30 Minutes of Every Booking Open the Delta app within 30 minutes of completing any booking and check My Trips. The booking should appear with the correct passenger name visible. Catching an error within 30 minutes of purchase almost certainly

means catching it within the 24-hour cancellation window where correction is free through cancel and rebook.

Habit 4: Save a Reference for Each Traveler's Legal Name For anyone who books Delta flights on behalf of others – corporate travel managers, executive assistants, family trip organizers – keeping a secure reference of each frequent traveler's legal name exactly as it appears on their travel ID eliminates transcription errors. A note or secure digital file showing "James Robert Thompson" rather than relying on memory for "Jim Thompson" prevents the nickname-vs-legal-name error that causes the largest proportion of name correction situations.

Habit 5: Set a 72-Hour Pre-Departure Check Setting a calendar reminder to check My Trips 72 hours before every Delta departure takes 30 seconds to schedule and catches any name issues, seat changes, or schedule modifications with adequate time to call ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 for resolution. This pre-departure check is the last reliable opportunity to address any issue with full processing time before the Secure Flight submission window.

How Name Changes Interact With Delta's Medallion Program

Delta Medallion status creates specific advantages in the name change process that non-status passengers do not have. Understanding these advantages helps Medallion members access the most efficient correction pathway.

Diamond and Platinum Medallion members access dedicated phone lines at ☎+1-(866)-332-0756 that route faster than standard queues. On a busy day when multiple passengers are calling simultaneously, Medallion priority access means reaching an agent faster while any time-sensitive same-day correction window remains open.

For legal name changes that require ticket reissuance, Medallion status is associated with higher-flexibility fare classes that are more likely to allow reissuance at the original fare without triggering a fare difference. The probability of a zero-cost legal name change reissuance is higher for Medallion-associated bookings in premium cabins than for non-status economy bookings.

Medallion status also affects how Delta's customer service team handles goodwill situations. A Diamond or Platinum member who encounters a name issue that creates a legitimate hardship – same-day travel with a name discrepancy caught at the checkpoint – receives more proactive assistance from supervisors than a non-status passenger in the same situation.

Award ticket reissuance for Medallion members: when a legal name change requires reissuance of a SkyMiles award ticket, Platinum and Diamond members have the standard redeposit fee waived if the reissuance process requires a cancellation and rebooking of the award. This fee waiver can save \$150 or more compared to the non-Medallion redeposit fee.

Call 📞+1-(866)-332-0756 and identify your Medallion status in the first sentence of any name change call. Status-based benefits in the name change process are not applied automatically unless the agent is aware of your tier from the start of the call.

Documentation Best Practices for International Name Changes

International travel with a corrected name requires additional documentation management beyond the boarding pass verification that suffices for domestic travel. Several best practices protect you at international checkpoints.

Carry your case reference number from the name correction call. This number allows any airline or airport agent worldwide to verify in Delta's system that the correction was processed legitimately. If an international check-in agent or immigration officer has questions about a name that appears different from what they expect, the case reference number supports your explanation.

Carry both your old and new ID if the correction relates to a legal name change. An immigration officer who sees a boarding pass in your new married name alongside your old passport (if the passport has not yet been updated to the new name) benefits from seeing the marriage certificate that connects the two names. This documentation package “old ID, marriage certificate, new ID” tells a complete and verifiable story.

Request a corrected itinerary email before international travel. When the agent at 📞+1-(866)-332-0756 processes a name correction, ask for a fresh itinerary confirmation to be sent to your email. Print this corrected itinerary and carry it. An official Delta document showing the correct name and matching the correction serves as supplementary documentation at any checkpoint where questions arise.

For travel to countries with strict name matching requirements “Japan, Australia, Canada, and most European Schengen countries enforce particularly rigorous document matching” complete the name correction at least 7 to 10 days before travel to allow full propagation through all relevant international systems including APIS submissions to destination country authorities.
